The objects of the Club, as stated in the constitution, are (a) to encourage and promote all that is possible to bring the natural qualities of Brittanys to perfection: (b) to urge members and breeders to accept the standard of the breed as approved by the American Kennel Club as the only standard of excellence by which Brittanys shall be judged: (c) to do all in its power to protect and advance the interest of the breed by encouraging sportsmanlike participation at dog shows, obedience trials and field trials under the rules of the American Kennel Club.
